# What is LibKey Nomad?


LibKey Nomad is an AI-supported browser extension that indicates whether the full text of a journal article or an e-book is licensed for RUB or open-access while you search the internet on various online platforms (e.g. Google Scholar, PubMed, Wikipedia, publishers' or booksellers' online stores) and finds the fastest way to it with AI support






### Where can I download it?

Directly from the company's download page: https://thirdiron.com/downloadnomad/



Choose "Ruhr-Universität Bochum" after installation





LibKey Nomad scans the pages you visit for publisher URLs - DOIs for articles or rather eISBNs for eBooks. If a website contains this information, you will see this icon:




In the display of such a title, LibKey checks whether RUB library has a license for it or whether open access is possible. Clicking the corresponding button will redirect you to the full text. For some providers (e.g. PubMed or Wikipedia), you can already see in the search result list or the list of references whether access is possible.



Example from PubMed:

Icons appear in the search result list






Example from Science Direct:

Icon appears in the individual record display of a title





• In google scholar it will set your library link to the RUB's library automatically. You will see the link "Full text via RUB" if the library provides access to it.



■ E-Books: Many websites now display LibKey Nomad icons that link to e-books, regardless of whether access is via the publisher's platform or an e-book aggregation site. When you click on the icon, you will be redirected to the website that grants access. The example is from Amazon; the icon takes you to the licensed full text on the Springer Nature website.





## How do I get the full text?

• The direct link to the PDF file opens it and you can save it on your device:



• If the full text isn't available online the icon "Access options" will transfer the article's data to our discovery system Primo. A print version may be available at one of RUB's libraries as in the example below. If not, you will be redirected to the interlibrary loan system.





## How do I get the full text?

N.B.: Activate the <u>VPN tunnel</u> (Login with LoginID.bib) before you start your literature search when you're not connected to the campus network. Some resources can also be used after logging in via <u>Shibboleth</u>, the provider will redirect you to the RUB Identity Management Portal.



## Is my data safe?

No personal registration required.

LibKey and LibKey Nomad are provided by BZ Disc/Third Iron in the USA. Users' IP addresses are usually stored for a week. Exceptionally, in cases in which this is necessary for matters of system security, users' IP addresses may be stored for up to 365 days. Storage and processing of data occurs in the USA.

Usage of LibKey/LibKey Nomad by UB Bochum is pursuant to art. 6, lib. e of GDPR. Transmission of data to the USA is pursuant to art. 46, paragraph 2 c GDPR.
