

Manual to register for an ORCID iD via the university bibliography

Check your name via the search option under <http://orcid.org/> to see whether you already have an ORCID iD. **Please do not register for a second iD!**

- **In case you already have an ORCID iD: Use the manual** “to create a shortcut between an existing ORCID iD and the university bibliography.”

If you still need an ORCID iD: Go to <https://bibliographie.ub.rub.de/orcid/> and click on “Create or Connect your ORCID iD”.

Create or Connect your ORCID ID

Explanation of the rights

(1) read limited

This scope is used to get access to 'read public' and 'limited visibility' items on an ORCID record. 'Private' items will only be visible to you. With the 'read limited' permission you will allow us to implement your publications from your ORCID-profile into the university bibliography.

(2) update activities

This scope is solely used to add new publications to your ORCID record, extract these for the university bibliography, and identifiably link you to your affiliation (in this case: RUB). You may also deactivate this permission and take care of your publications in your ORCID record yourself.

(3) update personal information

This scope is used to update and maintain external identifiers such as names of universities, websites and your researcher ID.

Please grant these rights and click “Create or Connect your ORCID iD”.

- Then fill out the following form with the required details (first name, last name, email etc.)
- The default setting is so that the information in your ORCID record is ‘visible’. If you wish to change this setting, you can do this here.
- Via “Email frequency” you can choose how often you would like to receive notifications (e.g. about changes in your ORCID record, news, events etc.)
- Verify that you are not a robot
- Consent to the privacy policy and the terms and conditions. You can click on both for more information
- Click on “Authorize”.
